Becoming a member of University Yacht Club connects you with people who enjoy boating, socializing and making friends in a family-friendly atmosphere. UYC provides a safe, clean and private environment in which to enjoy boating, social events, and just relaxing on the docks.



Welcome to the University Yacht Club. Founded in 1951, UYC is a member of the <u>United States Sailing Association</u> and is listed on the registry of the <u>Yachting Clubs of America</u>. UYC members participate in active power and sailing fleets that are berthed at Club docks shown below on the aerial view.

University Yacht Club is located on Lake Lanier in Flowery Branch, Georgia near Atlanta. Lake Lanier is a man-made lake covering 38,000 acres (150 sq km) of water and 692 miles (1,114 km) of shoreline at full pool, 1,071 feet (326 m) above mean sea level. It was named for poet Sidney Lanier and was built and is operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. It is patrolled by the Georgia Department of Natural Resources (GDNR).

# **Power Boating at University Yacht Club**

University Yacht Club is home to more than 100 cruisers, houseboats, ski boats, runabouts, jet skis and pontoon boats. Located on the southern branch of Lake Lanier, UYC is an ideal spot for those living in Metro Atlanta to come up for just a day at the lake.

If you are looking for the perfect place to dock your boat, look no further. At UYC, we have covered and uncovered slips that can accommodate boats up to 100 feet long. Due to our wonderful location at the end of a cove in a southern branch of Lake Lanier, our waters are generally calm. We are an active group and we participate in year-round activities and social events. In both Spring and Fall, we host a weekend raft-up on an island, usually with more than 25 boats (of all types). Floating and relaxing is a favorite summer pastime.

You can enjoy the use of our private mooring balls, located right off our beach area (the only mooring balls on the lake). These make it easy to relax and soak up the sun without cruising too far. The north cove features a beach area, an air-conditioned beach house with restrooms, a large deck and gazebo area for family gatherings and even a fire-pit for those chilly evenings. Our nearby Pavilion offers an enclosed and air-conditioned multifunction space, which is perfect to host a party or office function.

Enjoy meals in our dining room, or staff can deliver meals directly to your slip.

At UYC, we take our boating seriously, as we have many members who are actively involved in America's Boating Club Atlanta (formerly Atlanta Sail and Power Squadron) and have taken extensive courses in boating safety and navigation. They sponsor classes, provide vessel safety checks, and help inform UYC members on boating and safety issues throughout the year, making boating a more enjoyable sport. ABC also sponsors some boating trips in which many of our members participate.



# Sailing at University Yacht Club

The motto of our University Yacht Club Sail Fleet is "The Most Fun for the Most People." We try to live by that motto by enjoying a wide variety of sailing-oriented activities, both on and off the water. Sailors enjoy our club year-round, undaunted by the cold weather or varying lake levels. On any given weekend, you'll find UYC sailors actively involved in one or more of the following fun activities:

UYC Club Racing: We host two 5-race series each year and these races are what we call "friendly-competitive."

LARC Racing: We are members of the Lanier Auxiliary Racing Council and so our members can engage in racing that's a bit more competitive.

Hot Ruddered Bum and Lanier Cup Regattas: We are the host to both events that are the most fun regattas on Lanier each year and draw competitors from all around the lake.

Fun with Power-boaters: Sailors by their nature are a fun-loving lot and we enjoy the camaraderie of our power-boating members at their annual raft-up as well as on the various other events they host, like the Fall Leaf Cruise.

Support the Junior Program: There's nothing quite as much fun as watching young children figure out how to make a sailboat sail! Our Sail Fleet is always there to encourage and support the next generation of our sport.

Casual Cruising: We are blessed with a beautiful lake, and our wonderful location makes it easy to hop on our boats and head out for a cruise. There's nothing quite like enjoying a brilliant sunset while sailing along at dusk. Then it's home to UYC for a delicious meal at the clubhouse!

# **Junior Boating at University Yacht Club**

University Yacht Club is a family-friendly yacht club. We make every effort to include our children and grandchildren (and their friends) in many events, both on and off the water. Our Junior Boating Program is designed to allow our Juniors to enjoy themselves at the club while learning to enjoy boating related activities. We stress safety, sportsmanship and teamwork. The Program is geared towards young people from age 6 to 16 and is open to families of all UYC members and their friends.


The Juniors fleet includes Optimist Prams, Sunfish, Lasers, Holders and other small sailboats. The Program is managed by an experienced, paid, professional Program Director and a team of Certified Sailing Instructors. Members of UYC's Sail Fleet and Power Fleet support the Program by providing boats, running safety patrols during onthe-water activities and encouraging a fun, safe learning environment.

Every summer UYC hosts two Summer Sailing Camps for Juniors. Each session is a week-long day-camp that features activities both on and off the water. Shore activities include boating safety, boating terminology, "how-to" chalk-talks, knot tying and fun games. All our Juniors learn the basics of sailing and are able to demonstrate their ability to "show-off" their skills to parents and grandparents by the end of the week.

We are proud that our Junior Boating Program has grown steadily over the last several years, driven by the enthusiasm of the Juniors and their families and encouraged by the overwhelming support of the UYC Membership. We look forward to welcoming your young people to our Junior Boating Program at UYC.



# **Bulloch Chapel**



From the very beginning of UYC, many decades ago, our members wanted to enjoy their weekends at the Club and be able to attend worship services on Sunday morning – without having to travel back and forth to their "home" church. The initial solution was to conduct services in the Clubhouse on Sunday mornings, and that served us well for many years.

In 1991, thanks to the generous contributions of many of our members, we constructed the Bulloch Chapel, named after our first and long-time Fleet Chaplain, Frank Bulloch.

Our worship services are led by a Fleet Chaplain and an Assistant Fleet Chaplain, both of whom are ordained ministers.

Our beautiful and magnificent open-air Chapel is home for our summer (May-October) weekly worship services, which are non-denominational Christian services that include Morning Prayer, Holy Communion, sermons, testimonies and a variety of music. During the summer there are some special services, including, for example:

- Armed Forces Honor Day (Memorial Day Weekend)
- July 4 Eddie Staub, Founder of Eagle Ranch
- Prayer Healing Service
- Blessing of the Pets
- Congregational Sing-along (Congregation selects the hymns for the day)

During the "non-summer" months we have monthly services, conducted primarily in the warmth of the Carswell Pavilion, including, for example:

- Easter Sunrise Service (on the lawn overlooking the lake)
- Thanksgiving, where we remember the importance of Being a Blessing Unto Others
- Christmas Candlelight Lessons & Carols (UYC members and friends create a choir for this centerpiece of everything we do at the Club during December)
- New Year's Day, where we launch into the New Year with Holy Communion

Many who attend Chapel gather in the Clubhouse following services where our Chef offers a bountiful Sunday Brunch Buffet and members can continue to enjoy socializing.

The Chapel is available for Members to reserve for private functions. Over the years, many weddings and baptisms have taken place in the Chapel. It is also a peaceful place for funerals, memorial services, and Celebrations of Life.

We support Eagle Ranch and all they do to help the children and families they serve – with almost all of our Sunday offerings donated to Eagle Ranch.

Bulloch Chapel is a private, non-profit organization and can receive tax-deductible donations.



# Our Buildings and Facilities

We do our very best to maintain our property and buildings so that they are available for the enjoyment of all our members. Here's a summary of what we have:

- Clubhouse and Veranda Our Dining Room is in our clubhouse. Many of our landbased activities take place here. The Clubhouse includes restrooms with shower facilities.
- Bulloch Chapel Our beautiful open-air Chapel is home for our summer weekly worship services. The Chapel is available for Members to reserve for private functions. Over the years, many weddings and baptisms have taken place in the Chapel. It is also a peaceful place for funerals and memorial services.
- Carswell Pavilion Our lakeside Pavilion is where we conduct many large group activities, including our Board of Governors meetings and winter Chapel services. The Pavilion is temperature-controlled year-round and is available for Members to reserve for private functions which may be catered from the UYC kitchen.
- Beach House, Deck and Gazebo Our lakeside Beach House and Deck is a perfect setting for smaller group functions and meetings. The Beach House is also available to reserve for private functions and includes a self-serve laundry facility.
- Swim Beach and Swim Dock Located just below the Beach House, this facility is
  a special place for Members and their families who enjoy beach time. An outdoor
  shower is available for rinsing off sand.
- Courtesy Dock This dock can be used by visitors while dining or attending events.
   The General Manger / Office Manager can provide details for availability / assignment.

- Office Building and Ship's Store Our General Manager's office is located in the UYC Office. The online Ship's Store is a great place to find UYC logo attire. The actual Ship's Store has a small assortment of essential boating supplies. There is also a small meeting room available for Members use. The meeting room also doubles as the UYC Library and is full of books available to Members. The Office Building also includes restrooms for men and women with shower facilities.
- Houseboat-sized gas dock and pump-out facility Our private gas dock has competitive rates usually below other marinas and offers ethanol-free gasoline.
- Launch ramp Our ramp boasts one of the deepest launch ramps on the lake and is located next to the club office building.
- Bagged Ice We offer bagged ice conveniently located outside the Office Building.
- The Cottage and the Chalet these two buildings are available for Members to rent for themselves or for their families and friends (assuming Member and/or spouse are on the Club property). The Cottage is a 2 bedroom/2 bath facility and the Chalet is a 1 bedroom/1 bath facility. Both have kitchen facilities and are equipped for cooking. Reservations can be made through the Club Office.
- Manager's Home Our General Manager has living quarters on our property.

- 1. The Principal Sponsor obtains an application packet from the Membership Chair, the UYC website, or the UYC Office. This packet contains a letter of instruction for the Principal Sponsor, membership application, Rules and Regulations, and other enclosures as requested by the Membership Committee.
- 2. The completed Application must be signed by the Principal Sponsor and two additional sponsors who are personally acquainted with the applicant. A letter of recommendation from each of the three sponsors is submitted to the Membership Committee prior to final approval of the application for membership.
- 3. The Membership Chair will coordinate with the Principal Sponsor to ensure that the applicant meets any three of the current Bridge Officers, Governors, and a minimum of three members of the Membership Committee.
- 4. The Chair of the Membership Committee will present the application to the Board of Governors for a first reading at the next meeting following receipt of the completed application. The application is then posted on the UYC Office bulletin board for at least ten days prior to the second reading.
- 5. The Board of Governors will consider the applicant (i.e., the Second Reading) after: the required introductions have been made; the Membership Chair reviews the applicant with the Bridge Officers, Governors and members of the Membership Committee who have met the applicant; and has reviewed all relevant information concerning the applicant.
